From Fr. Cloherty

Of many things:

- Two important consultation meetings will be held in the near future to help us move forward with our parish religious education program for children grades 1-10 and their parents. At 7 p.m. on Thursday, June 11, there will be a meeting for current and former religious education teachers. At 7 p.m. on Thursday, June 18, there will be a meeting for parents of all the children in our program. Both meetings will be held in our church hall. Please enter through the enclosure at the left of the front of the church. After these meetings, our Parish Religious Education Task Force will consult with the Archdiocese about how to proceed with a program for grades 1-10 for 2009-10.
- Starting July 1, all parents planning to have an infant baptized at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish must tell those they are asking to be godparents for the child to request a statement from their local parish testifying they are active members. This statement must be delivered/mailed to our rectory before the pre-baptism class. Canon Law requires certainty of a well-founded hope the child will be raised in the Church. To date this was not required, but we have decided to implement this requirement to ensure that godparents will be committed to the future nurturing of the child in faith.
- Next Sunday will be CORI Sunday in our parish. If you have potential access to children or frail elderly people as a ministry volunteer in the parish and have not yet signed a CORI form for 2009-10, please do so at the church doors next weekend. Photo ID will be required.
- On Wednesday, September 16, 2009 there will be an appreciation banquet for priests in the Archdiocese. It is a fundraiser with a goal to raise \$1,000,000 for the Clergy Benefit Trust that supports retired and disabled priests. Each parish in the Archdiocese is being asked to buy a table for 10 at \$5,000 a table. This is not an item in our parish budget. Help would be appreciated from any quarter.
- We need volunteers to organize and run games for children at our annual parish picnic from 11:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday, June 20. If you can help, please call the rectory.
